PROGRAM INTRODUCTION

CoSIDA has selected Academic All-America[®] Teams of outstanding student-athletes continuously since 1952. In 1988, CoSIDA decided to extend the Teams program to honor former Academic All-America Team members who have outstanding accomplishments in their professions and have made substantial contributions to their communities. The CoSIDA Academic All-America Hall of Fame[®] was created to honor these individuals.

NOMINATION CRITERIA

- Candidate must be nominated by the institution's Sports Information Director. There is no limit to the number of nominees from any institution.
- Candidate must have been an Academic All-America Team member during his/her collegiate career or must meet the criteria for an Honorary Inductee.
- Candidate must have community service accomplishments.
- Candidate must have graduated with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Candidate's class must be graduated for at least 10 years.
- The institution's Officer of Compliance and Eligibility must sign the nomination form to certify its accuracy.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

- Sports Information Directors forward completed 2005 Academic All-America Hall of Fame Nomination Forms to Joe Onderko at Westminster College (Fax, 724-946-7187, or E-mail, onderkjm@westminster.edu). **To resubmit a previous nomination, a nomination form does not need to be filled out. Please submit a letter of intent and updated biographical information to Joe.**
- All forms must be completed in their entirety and received by **Monday, February 28, 2005.**
- A ballot consisting of all eligible candidates will be prepared and sent to the CoSIDA Academic All-America Committee and Board of Directors, which is returned to Joe Onderko at Westminster. The top 25 candidates receiving the most votes are placed on the final ballot.
- Sports Information Directors of the finalists submit detailed biographical information on their candidates.
- The Hall of Fame Selection Committee reviews the nomination and biographical information and selects a maximum of four inductees and, when warranted, an Honorary Inductee.

HONORARY INDUCTEE

Presented to a person who has made a significant contribution to the goals and ideals of the Academic All-America Committee, Team or Hall of Fame. It may be awarded to a former student-athlete whose collegiate career preceded the Academic All-America Teams program in his/her sport. Honorary members include Lester Jordan, John Wooden, Byron White, Dick Enberg, Marv Levy, Dr. Sherwood Rowland, Dr. Gary Hall, Sr., Gov. Raymond Shafer and Rolf Benirschke. To nominate a candidate, please follow the year of eligibility per sport listed below, fill out the attached form and check the box that indicates Honorary nomination. Football 1952, Basketball 1963, Baseball 1970, Women's Basketball 1979, Volleyball 1982 and Softball and At-Large 1983.
